



### Security Dog First Aid Level 2

Taking care of our canine partners is becoming part of tactical emergency casualty care. Military medics are trained to expected to take of wounded working dogs.

The nature of working with dogs will increase the risk of injury whilst at work or while being transported. This course you will learn what to do with common injuries, how to manage massive haemorrhages, airway management, extrication, keeping within your scope of practice.

It is ideally suited to working dog handlers, team medics who wish to up skill to include working dogs. The course is approved by NASDU.

The instructor is ex Royal Army Veterinary Corps, dog trainer and handler with operational experience with security, explosive and tracker dogs.

The course can be stand alone, or there is an option to embed within a longer FREC or first aid course.

### The syllabus includes:

- Checking Dogs health.
- First aid kits.
- Trauma, stop the bleed, soft tissue injuries.
- CPR
- Medical conditions

**Duration:** One day.

**Entry Criteria:** No prior qualifications required.

**Certification:** Security Dog First Aid Level 2 Valid for 3 years.
