Catastrophic bleeding is life threatening and can kill in minutes so having a fast and effective method of stopping bleeding is a must have life skill in the workplace, out and about and at home.

This course covers the main types of commercial tourniquets including the CAT, MAT, and SOFT T, as well as improvised tourniquets. Haemostatic dressings from Celox, Quick Clot, and other Haemostatic dressings and powders are also included. The course also covers the use of trauma dressings including the Air Wrap dressings.
