Paediatric First Aid Level 3 (PFA)

This is unit 2, the course meets and exceeds the requirements laid down by Ofsted and EYFS for people needing a 2-day 12 contact hour first aid course for Infant and child.

It is now a requirement that everyone working in childcare have a paediatric first aid qualification.

Available as a blended option.

The syllabus includes:

- The Role of the First Aider
- First Aid Equipment
- Patient assessment
- Trauma management
- Manage catastrophic bleeding
- Assess and manage patient's airway
- Record keeping
- Manage a patient with head and spinal injuries
- Manage a patient with injuries to bones, muscles and joints

Duration: 2 days.

Entry Criteria: No prior qualifications required.

Certification: PFA Level 3. Valid for 3 years.

- Basic Life Support and AED training Infant and Child.
- Environmental emergencies
- Minor illness and injury
- Medical emergencies
