

First Response Emergency Care Level 3 Requalification



(FREC 3 Requalification)

The Qualsafe First Response Emergency Care Requalification (Level 3 RQF) covers the full range of skills required to fulfil the competencies set out in the PHEM skills framework at descriptor level D (Advanced Provider) to retain your FREC 3.

The training focuses on providing effective pre hospital care.

Training is held at our venue in Buckinghamshire, with emphasise on practical elements.

The syllabus includes:

- Basic medical planning
- Incident assessment
- Patient assessment
- Trauma management
- Manage catastrophic bleeding
- Assess and manage patient's airway
- Administer emergency oxygen
- Manage a patient with head and spinal injuries
- Manage a patient with injuries to bones, muscles and joints

- Adult Basic Life Support and AED training
- Environmental emergencies
- Minor illness and injury
- Medical emergencies
- Introduction to multiple casualty management & triage
- Casualty evacuation
- Scenario-based practical skills training interventions

Duration: 3 days.

Entry Criteria: Previous attendance on a FREC 3 within the last three years; certificate must still be in date.

Certification: Qualsafe Awards Level 3 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care. Valid for 3 years.
